Scooter Registration Process

Before you can ride your new SreetScoota on public roads it needs to be registered with the DVLA and have a number plate fitted.

Don't worry, Ego Scooter Ltd will take responsibility for the legal registration of your scooter, which includes obtaining a tax disc and registration plate.

Simply follow the instructions detailed below:

- 1) Send the following documents by recorded delivery to Ego Scooter at the above address:
 - Current driving licence (photocard and paper licence)
 - Valid certificate of Insurance or cover note
 - Utility bill within last 3 months confirming your address
- 2) Ego Scooter will then register the scooter with the DVLA and acquire your number plate
- 3) Ego Scooter will then send the following back to the customer by recorded delivery approximately 10 working days after customer posted original documents:
 - Tax disc
 - Number plate with fixing screws
 - Certificate of conformity (for safekeeping)
 - Return of driving licence, insurance certificate and utility bill
- 4) Log book from DVLA will be sent direct to customer at later date

Note: Insurance can be obtained via nominated partner who can send cover note directly to Ego Scooter address if required – *see attached information*
